Opportunity to participate in an online focus group with European trainees.

Dear future child and adolescent psychiatrist,

At some point in your career as a child and adolescent psychiatrist, you may start to think about combining your clinical work with a role in research, leadership or teaching. Thus far during your training, you may or may not have already experienced opportunities to prepare for these 'double-roles'. Some of these experiences may have been interesting and encouraging and other experiences may have been rather disappointing or discouraging.

We would like to offer you the opportunity to reflect on how your training does or does not prepare for these double roles in child and adolescent psychiatry. To help you explore your views we are organizing focus groups with trainees in child and adolescent psychiatry in an international, European, perspective.

The focus group which will take approximately 1,5h. We will discuss in a small group of international trainees what helps and hampers taking on double roles in CAP training.

As a participating trainee you don't have to combine double roles or have an ambition to do so. All views are welcome. As a participant you can be still in CAP training or recently graduated; most important is that you still experience the subject from a trainee perspective.
